POOL POLICIES & RULES

1. WARNING! There will be no lifeguard on duty at any time. Swim at your own risk. North Lakes Homes Association is not responsible for accidents or injuries.
2. Children 14 years of age and under must be accompanied by a parent or have adult supervision (18+ years old) at all times. Children should be encouraged to go to the restroom before entering the pool.
3. The pool will be open daily and the water will be tested (2) or more times daily, by the pool committee or their designees, who have the power to close the pool.
4. The season for swimming is Memorial Day through Labor Day.
5. Hours for the pool are 9am to 8pm. If anyone would like access to the pool, before/after normal pool hours, e-mail pool@northlakeliving.com.
6. Guest must be accompanied by a resident of North Lakes in good standing. The Board reserves limiting the number of guests allowed per person.
7. No smoking or vaping allowed in or around the pool.
8. No gum chewing around the pool area.

SAFETY RULES

1. NO DIVING ALLOWED AT ANY TIME.
2. Be polite and considerate- NO yelling, inappropriate public displays of affection, abusive, or foul language will not be allowed.
3. Glass containers of any kind are not allowed in or around the pool area.
4. No running, pushing or other dangerous horseplay is allowed around the pool gated area.
5. No oversized rafts, water guns, blasters, soakers, or any water projecting mechanisms are allowed in the gated area.
6. No swimming during rain or electrical storms.
7. The floating rope divider must remain in place at all times.
8. Bather load is 25 persons.

HEALTH RULES

1. Persons with any contagious disease, infectious condition (such as colds, fever, ringworm, foot infections, skin lesions, carbuncles, boils, inflamed eyes, ear discharges or other conditions that appear infectious), excessive sunburn, abrasions, weeping wounds, adhesive tape, or bandages are not permitted.
2. Infants and toddlers three years old or younger, or not toilet trained, or anyone who lacks control of urine or defecation must wear a water resistant swim diaper and waterproof swimmer. Skin diapers and waterproof swimmer must have waist and leg openings fitted such that they are in contact with the waist or leg around the entire circumference.
3. Diapers may only be changed in restrooms.
4. NO UNSANITARY HABITS WILL BE TOLERATED.
5. The pool will immediately be closed for cleaning in the event of fecal or vomitus discharge. All bathers will be ordered to leave the pool until these substances are removed.
6. Proper swimming attire is required - street clothes, jeans cut-offs, tennis shoes, are not to be worn in the pool.
7. No smoking or vaping allowed in or around the pool.
8. No gum chewing around the pool area.
9. No pets are allowed inside the pool gate.
10. All trash must be placed in the appropriate container.

Please help everyone follow these rules so we can keep the pool open as much as possible.
A KCMO Health Department representative DOES make regular visits to the pool.
The NL HOA also reserves the right to deny the use of the pool to anyone at anytime.
